Section 3, hereby certify that the following is a true copy of the agreement of association to form
said corporation, with the names of the subscribers thereto:

We, whose names are hereto subscribed, do, by this agreement, associate ourselves with the
intention of forming a corporation under the provisions of General Laws, Chapter 180.

The name by which the corporation shall be known is

THE PROTESTANT GUILD FOR THE BLIND, INC.

The location of the principal office of the corporation in Massachusetts is to be the
City of Boston Street 14 Beacon

The purposes for which the corporation is formed are as follows:

The Corporation shall engage in activities that contribute to the spiritual, social, moral, educational and temporal welfare of the blind and visually handicapped, particularly those of the Protestant Faith; and in furtherance of these purposes the Corporation shall cooperate with existing churches, agencies, organizations, including the Massachusetts Council of Churches, a Massachusetts corporation, or organizations which may hereafter be established in promoting all and every interest of the blind and partially blind; and shall provide and supervise a Religious Education program for Protestant children attending Perkins Institution & Massachusetts School for the Blind; and may collect and receive donations for the general purposes of the Corporation and accept donations on conditions designated by the donor and accepted by the Corporation; and shall possess, own, construct, improve, lease, remodel, acquire by purchase, gift, bequest, or otherwise, such real and personal property as may be necessary, proper or convenient for the execution of these purposes.
